

PMI & TPTCM Birth Outcome Cards January 2018



This Technical Assistance Brief describes the Birth Outcome Card and when it should be selected to capture post-natal (birth outcome) data vs. the Pregnancy Maintenance Initiative (PMI) or Teen Pregnancy Targeted Case Management (TPTCM) Service Form.

What is a Birth Outcome Card?

The Birth Outcome Card is a form created in DAISEY to capture post-natal data elements available to the program when a client does not return for a post-natal visit. This information was not always captured in DAISEY due to lack of contact with the client after delivery. This data is critical to reflect actual program outcomes and for fundamental State reporting requirements.

Note: If a post-natal visit is conducted, the birth outcome data will be captured in the PMI or TPTCM Service Form.

Criteria for using this option:

- ❖ The client did not return for a post-natal visit.
- ❖ The client was enrolled and actively engaged in the program at the time of delivery.

Post-natal data elements:

All post-natal visit follow up questions included on the program Service Form are required on the Birth Outcome Card.

The following data elements are *system required*:

- Which caregiver was involved?
- Date of activity (date grantee received the birth outcome information)
- Date of infant's birth
- Gestational age of infant at birth (in weeks)
- Fetal/infant death
